

ESSENTIAL CIVIL WAR CURRICULUM

Bob Zeller is the author or co-author of a dozen trade books and publications on a variety of topics, including four works on Civil War photography. As co-founder and president of the non-profit Center for Civil War Photography, Inc., www.civilwarphotography.org, Zeller is a leading authority on the subject.

His Civil War photography books include *Lincoln in 3-D*, (San Francisco: Chronicle Books, 2010), co-authored with John J. Richter. His two-volume *The Civil War in Depth: History in 3-D*, (San Francisco: Chronicle Books, 1997) was the first book to show Civil War photos in their original stereoscopic format. He wrote the only book-length, scholarly history of Civil War photography, *The Blue and Gray in Black and White: A History of Civil War Photography*, (Santa Barbara, CA: Praeger, 2005). He co-authored *Antietam in 3D* (Gahanna, OH: Center for Civil War Photography, 2012) with John J. Richter and Gary E. Adelman.

Zeller, 61, is a native of Washington, D.C., and a graduate of the University of Missouri School of Journalism (B.J. '74). He spent 25 years in newspaper journalism as a reporter, investigative journalist and motorsports writer before becoming a self-employed writer in 1999.
